
AVE MARIA CATHOLIC CHURCH

Can a person habitually forget God and be holy? Every Advent season, we are called to reaffirm that we belong to God. We are in the world, but we do not belong to the world, and God is our Lord.

The problem of worldliness can be resolved by this idea: the forgetfulness that we are creatures. This forgetfulness is the source of almost all sins of omission.

A worldly person never looks like someone who lives as having to give an account to a higher power. Wherever there is worldliness, there is this forgetfulness: forgetfulness that we are limited and forgetfulness that there is a God.

The Word of God came to the world to teach us that even though we are in the world, we do not belong to the world. We are called to live the life of the blessed in heaven.

Every Advent, we proclaim that holiness is not idealism but is the consequence of being a follower of Christ. This Advent, let us return to Jesus and profess that we belong to Him.

Holy Matrimony


Marriage is a union of love and a response to God's call to holiness.





On Friday, December 16, from 6:30-7:30 PM, Ave Maria Parish will offer a Penance Service at the Church. Several priests will be available for confessions, and the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for public adoration.


If you regularly come to confession—please continue with this practice. If you haven't been to the sacrament in a while, please come back. Invite others to come as well—after all, Advent is the time for a renewal in Christ.

Jesus tells us: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest" (Mt 11:28). Isn't his message the very essence of the Good News? Please, hear Jesus' call, and come to have your burdens lifted in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Come, be healed and restored. Jesus, our most merciful, loving, forgiving God will be waiting for you.

We learn from the *United States Catholic Catechism for Adults*:

Confession, also known as Penance and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, is an experience of the gift of God's boundless mercy.

Jesus entrusted the ministry of reconciliation to the Church. The Sacrament of Penance is God's gift to us so that any sin committed after Baptism can be forgiven. In confession, we have the opportunity to repent and recover the grace of friendship with God. It is a holy moment in which we place ourselves in his presence and honestly acknowledge our sins. With absolution, we are reconciled to God and the Church. The Sacrament helps us stay close to the truth that we cannot live without God.

Quisiéramos hacerles conocer los números finales de nuestra encuenta por el cambio de día y horario de la Misa en español en nuestra parroquia.


- 141 personas manifestaron que preferían la Misa los domingos a las 5:00 PM (73.8%).

COLIC BANDS to hold Him tight: you won't fuss when they send you something that you don't like, but do what they say.

BABY CAP: study and do everything for Jesus, thinking about His love.

MANGER: don't slack off in bed; go to Mass and receive Communion.

STRAW: doing some small act, like depriving yourself of sweets or eating something you don't like.

Do everything for the love of Jesus... Good bye. I will pray for everything you tell me. Your unworthy Carmelite sends you a hug.
