
AVE MARIA CATHOLIC CHURCH



Please find enclosed the financial statements of Ave Maria Parish for the fiscal year 2021-2022. As you review the numbers, you will notice that our Parish had its first year of positive cash flow, making all our loan interest payments and a payment of \$600,000 toward the loan principal! That also means that the parish will receive a 20% match (\$120,000) credited toward the loan balance. All this was done while maintaining and improving parish grounds and buildings and increasing our pastoral mission. This is indeed a reason for celebration!

In addition, many of you have also supported our Parish School. During this past fiscal year, because of your generosity, the Capital Campaign and the Angel's Fund of the School have raised almost \$600,000! Now, the School is adding four new classrooms to the existing building.

We are humbled by your kindness and generosity! We are grateful for your sacrificial offering! We are encouraged in our work for the building of Ave Maria Parish and Donahue Academy, our Parish School!

We know that there is still much to be done. We want to keep maintaining and beautifying our Church and grounds as we continue to reduce our debt. We would also like to start planning our future Parish Center. Besides, we cannot lose sight of the importance of expanding our Parish School to accommodate the many requests we have. We know it is a great challenge, but we are confident that all is possible with God's help and your answer to God's call to imitate His generosity! But now, let us take a moment to celebrate! This is the moment to say THANK YOU! And GOD BLESS YOU!



Religious Education

The below programs will be starting Sunday, September 11, 2022, from 11:15 am -12:15 pm at Donahue Academy/Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) Atrium located on the 3rd floor of the bank building:

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS)-Kindergarten and First Grade (1st year First Communion Preparation): A reflective-based program of religious formation that is rooted in Scripture and the Liturgy.

2nd Year First Communion Preparation: the core of the program is the Catholic Children's Bible. The students will explore the sacraments through the biblical lens of Jesus' life and works and learn more about their faith in language they can understand.

Bridges to Faith-continual catechesis/1st year sacramental preparation for 3rd-5th grades: the essentials of the Catholic Faith for ages 8 to 11 are centered on the four pillars of the Catechismthe Creed, the sacraments, the moral life and prayer.

Called to Be Catholic/RCIC-continual catechesis /sacramental preparation for 6th-8th graders: A highly flexible resource that provides young people with a comprehensive introduction to the essentials and key teachings of the four pillars of the Catholic faith. Along with the YOUCAT (Youth Catechism of the Catholic Church) these resources will fill in faith formation gaps for young people ages 12 to 15 and prepare students to receive sacraments at the Easter Vigil.










